ART&IDEA OPENS IN NEW YORK

Art&Idea, the nonprofit art space founded in Mexico City in 1995, is opening a commercial gallery in New York's Chelsea art district on July 20, 2006. The inaugural show at the new gallery, located at 529 West 20th Street, is "Concrete-Skeleton," a site-specific installation by Mexico City-based artist **Javier Hinojosa**.
